Dear Saints from graduating batch of 2024,

1. The release of the 2024 GCE A-Level examination results will take place on 21 February 2025 (Friday) at 2.30 pm.

### Collection of Examination Results

2. You may collect your result slips and certificates in the **school hall** from 2.30 pm on 21 February 2025.

3. For the release of 2024 A-Level Examination Results, all candidates regardless of whether they are in Singapore or overseas, will be able to access their results online via Singapore Examinations and Assessment Board (SEAB)'s Candidates Portal at [www.seab.gov.sg](http://www.seab.gov.sg) from 3.15pm on Friday, 21 February 2025 till 11 pm on Friday, 7 March 2025. Should you be unwell on the day of the results release, it is advisable to exercise social responsibility and not return to school to collect your results, and to collect it online instead.

4. School candidates who are eligible for SingPass<sup>1</sup> can use their SingPass account to access SEAB's Candidates portal. GCE A-Level candidates who are eligible for Singpass are to apply and activate their Singpass account so that they can view their results online. For students whose Singpass PIN had expired, they can reset their password instantly online or request for a new PIN mailer via Singpass website ([www.singpass.gov.sg](http://www.singpass.gov.sg)). School candidates who are International Students will receive their system-generated username via email from Wednesday, 19 February 2025.

6. School candidates who wish to receive their hardcopy results but are unable to do so on the day of the A-Level results release may authorise proxies to collect the results on their behalf. These candidates are required to complete the authorisation letter from the college website and collect the collaterals from the General Office during office hours from Monday to Friday.

### Applications to Autonomous Universities

7. Applications for admissions and/or scholarships to the local Autonomous Universities (AUs) can be done online. All school candidates who apply to the local AUs online do not need to submit a copy of their A-Level certificates. More information on the AUs' admissions processes can be found on their respective websites, and applicants can approach the AUs directly for further clarifications.

## Annex A - QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS FOR 2024 SINGAPORE-CAMBRIDGE GCE A-LEVEL EXAMINATION RESULTS RELEASE

1	<p><b>Can I ask somebody to collect my results slip &amp; certificate on my behalf?</b></p> <p>For the release of 2024 A-Level Examination Results, all candidates regardless of whether they are in Singapore or overseas, will be able to access their results online via SEAB's Candidates Portal (<a href="http://www.seab.gov.sg">www.seab.gov.sg</a>) from 3.15pm on Friday, 21 February 2025 till 11 pm on Friday, 7 March 2025.</p> <p><b>Candidates may refer to the Candidate Portal user guide (<a href="#">CP user-guide</a>)</b></p>
2	<p><b>Can I collect the hardcopy of my results slip &amp; certificate on another day?</b></p> <p>School candidates who wish to receive their hardcopy results but are unable to do so on the day of the A-Level results release, may collect their results from the General Office during office hours from Monday to Friday or nominate a proxy to collect on behalf. The proxy should first make an appointment with the college on the time and date. The proxy must bring the authorisation letter (available from the college website: <a href="https://standrewsjc.moe.edu.sg/">https://standrewsjc.moe.edu.sg/</a>) and all required documentation on the day of collection. All results are to be collected by Monday, 03 March 2025, 4 pm.</p>
3	<p><b>I am currently overseas, can the college mail the hardcopy collaterals?</b></p> <p>No. All hardcopy collaterals will not be posted. Students can authorise a proxy via the authorisation letter and collect the collaterals from the General Office during office hours from Monday to Friday. The proxy must bring the authorisation letter (available from the college website: <a href="https://standrewsjc.moe.edu.sg/">https://standrewsjc.moe.edu.sg/</a>) and all required documentation on the day of collection.</p>
4	<p><b>Can I as a proxy collect the hardcopy of my friend's results slip &amp; certificate if I am from a different class?</b></p> <p>Yes. Collection can be made at the General Office <b>from 4 pm</b>. The proxy must submit the authorisation letter (available from the college website: <a href="https://standrewsjc.moe.edu.sg/">https://standrewsjc.moe.edu.sg/</a>) to the general office and bring all required documentation on the day of collection.</p>
5	<p><b>Can I as a proxy collect the hardcopy of my friend's results slip &amp; certificate if I am from the same class?</b></p> <p>Yes. Collection can be made from your CT/CTA. The proxy must submit the authorisation letter (available from the college website: <a href="https://standrewsjc.moe.edu.sg/">https://standrewsjc.moe.edu.sg/</a>) to your CT/CTA and bring all required documentation on the day of collection.</p>
